1. The Board is responsible for an annual performance review of the principal.
2. The Assistant Superintendent will conduct an evaluation of the Principal during his second year of service and then every three years thereafter. The results of these evaluations will be presented to the Superintendent and the Board at a regularly scheduled meeting.

F. I have made the following recommendations to Susie Riegel Superintendent of the Greenville City Schools to present to the Greenville Board of Education.

2. The hourly rate for the tutoring position be set at \$20 an hour including benefits. This person would work a maximum of 2 1/2 hours a day. Only gets paid for hours worked.
3. do not use the Modular this year, have the classes that were held in the Modular in Mrs. Wetzel's homeroom.

As I have told you before, we have been told to be conservative on funding, \$500 per student from Auxillary funds. Cost Reimbursement will be approx. \$225 per student, last year approx. \$280 per student. With a loss of 9 students that means we will be receiving approx. \$20,000 less than we did last year.
